

PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

Yaguars Sports and Social Club is committed to ensuring that all players have the opportunity to participate in a safe and welcoming environment that is encouraging and promotes their overall development. Parents have an enormous influence on their child's experiences in the

sport. The quality of the team experience is strongly influenced by the relationships with parents. In this code "parents" shall refer to "parents and guardians". This code applies to all parents who are members of Yaguars Sports and Social Club. Parents shall abide by this code at all times while participating in any Yaguars Sports and Social Club practice, game or activity.

- 1. All parents are expected to conduct themselves in a responsible manner consistent with the values of fair play, integrity, open communication and mutual respect.
- 2. Parents shall always model positive responsible behaviour and communicate with their son/daughter that they expect them to do the same. Parents will assume the major responsibility for their sons/daughters on field conduct and attitude.
- 3. Parents shall always treat all individuals and property with dignity, courtesy and respect, including but not limited to teammates, coaches, officials, volunteers, other parents, and all other individuals that are part of Yaguars Sports and Social Club, district, provincial or national organizations.
- 4. Parents shall refrain from any behaviour, or comments, which are profane, insulting, harassing, sexist, racist, abusive, disrespectful or otherwise offensive without hostility or violence.
- 5. Parents shall emphasize the importance of values like sportsmanship, respect, cooperation, competition and teamwork to their son/daughter offering praise for competing fairly, participation and skill development.
- 6. Parents shall model and encourage their son/daughter to maintain a healthy balance between sport and life.
- 7. Parents shall model and encourage balanced, healthy food choices and subscribing to an active and healthy lifestyle.
- 8. Parents shall set reasonable expectations for their son/daughter's participation in sports focusing on development and enjoyment for the child.
- 9. Parents shall instill confidence in their son/daughter's ability and skill development, always avoiding comparisons with other players.
- 10. Parents shall celebrate the acquisition of skills and goals achieved by their son/daughter.
- 11. Parents main concern is the child's overall progress and development.
- 12. A parent's role shall be to take a healthy interest in their child's progress and development and be responsible for the child's nutrition, rest, adherence to a training regimen set by the coach or other fitness professional, overall health, life-balance, and moral and emotional support.
- 13. Parents shall ensure their son/daughter wears proper clothing and equipment. Sports equipment will vary dependent on the sport, the field type and parents should be diligent to ensure cleats, futsal, gym and turf shoes are all worn on the appropriate surfaces. Parents must also ensure the proper use of shin guards. Players that require the use of glasses must use sport spectacles during all active play including practice, fitness sessions and games.
- 14. Parents shall never provide alcohol or drugs to minors in a Yaguars Sports and Social Club activity, event or competition.
- 15. Parents shall follow Niagara Region By-laws regarding consumption of alcohol and drugs in city parks and facilities.
- 16. Parents shall always follow the Smoke-Free Ontario Act, 2017 regarding the legally permitted areas in which smoking and vaping are permitted.
- 17. Parents shall never provide or advocate the use of performance enhancing drugs or substances.
- 18. Parents shall avoid any conduct, which brings Yaguars Sports and Social Club, into disrepute.
- 19. Parents shall openly support and uphold this code of conduct policy and take action and steps to ensure other parents follow and uphold this code of conduct policy.
- 20. Parents shall adhere to the policies, procedures, rules, standards, and ethics of Yaguars Sports and Social Club, Regional, Provincial and National policies of the regulatory sports organizations and their procedures as stated in manuals and online resources. As an example, for Soccer will be NSA, Ontario Soccer and Canada Soccer.
- 21. Parents shall never promote profanity and/or violence at any Yaguars Sports and Social Club practice, game or event.
- 22. Parents shall demonstrate tolerance and an acceptance of diversity at all times.
